Camper Welcome and Rules

Welcome to Granite Ridge!

We are SO excited that you are here to enjoy God's creation with your group. Even though it may feel like there are no rules out here in the country, here are a few to keep in mind:

- 1. There is a strict 15MPH speed limit on all dirt roads on and around the property. Please respect the safety of our neighbors and also our air quality!
- 2. Parking will be in designated dirt lot behind basketball court unless otherwise noted help us save our sprinklers by not parking on grass
- 3. Please DO NOT handle any wildlife (even though the bunnies may look so darn cute). Let the staff know immediately of any abnormal animal sightings (rattlesnakes, bears, mountain lions, etc.)
- 4. No going into the water without a lifejacket or a staff's permission
- 5. Noise carries out here. Amplified music must be turned off by 9:30PM and all loud activities must be wrapped up by 10:00 PM and moved indoors
- 6. Walk in groups of 2's or 3's when "exploring", especially at dawn and dusk (this includes runners)
- 7. Please respect our neighbors and stay only on Granite Ridge property. No climbing fences. If you don't know if something is off limits, just ask!
- 8. Dress Code will be enforced at the Dining Hall and during Group Activities
 - a. Footwear must be worn at all times closed toe shoes during activities
 - b. Shirts must be worn during meals and activities
 - c. Modest swimwear for both guys and girls please
- 9. Dining Hall Rules
 - a. Meals will be signaled by ringing of the bell (8AM, 12PM, and 6PM)
 - b. Groups will be in charge of bussing their own tables and wiping down tables/chairs
- * Granite Ridge staff is here to make your experience the best possible. Please let us know if you need anything at all (toilet's unclogged, extra food, more fans, etc.)

We cannot help you if you do not ask!

Other Things to Note:

- While our property is great for "unplugging", we do have campus WiFi available at \$3 per day.
- Campfires are permitted on a case by case basis depending on fire restrictions and staff availability.
